

2011 SPIN THREE SPOOKTACULAR RULES

- Dress code is western attire: cowboy hat, long sleeve shirt, jeans and boots
- \$10 hat fine in the open class and \$5 hat fine in the youth class
- Pee Wee ages are 8 and under, Youth ages are 9-16, age is as of the first of October
- No times may be carried over; if you enter the class, you must run in the class
- Check the draw for positions, all positions will be drawn
- A scratch will not change the draw order.
- If running more than one horse, you may not choose which horse runs first. Make sure you are on the correct horse, if you run the wrong horse you will be disqualified
- A horse cannot be ran in the same class more than once unless the two people running the horse are immediate family members (ie. mom, dad, brother, sister, grandma) who live in the same household. Under no circumstance shall the same horse be ran more than twice in the same class
- If you pre-enter for time only runs, tickets will be available in the office. All other time only runs can be purchased at the gate
- Barrels will be set off the markers for time only runs
- Tractor rake every 7 runs; Whole arena rake at half way point
- Any abuse, abusive language or misconduct toward persons or animal may result in disqualification
- Contestant will get three calls. If the contestant is not in the arena by the third call they will be disqualified.
- Contestant must begin run within one minute after entering the arena
- Contestant may make ONE circle to begin the run
- Alley way must be kept clear at all times
- Unattended horses will not be allowed in the holding area inside the barn
- A no time will result if a contestant breaks the barrel pattern, tips a barrel over or runs out of turn
- After the pre-entry deadline has passed, you may vet out with a written vet release. You may either substitute a different horse for that position or you will receive a refund for your entry fees, less a \$10 office fee
- There will be a \$10 per person per day late fee and all late entries **MUST BE PAID IN CASH**
- Late entries will be drawn at the end
- There will be a \$30 fee assessed on all returned checks
- Dogs must be on leashes and attached to a person at all times and absolutely no dogs in the arena or holding area
- If the timer fails, the contestant will be given a re-run at the end of the class or at the producers discretion
- A re-run will not be given if a horse falls
- Entries will close at the time specified. All monies must be paid by the time entries close!
- All posted arena rules must be followed
- Please do not clean out your horse trailers in the parking lot. If you do so and are caught you may be assessed a fine
- The producers of the race will settle all disputes and the producers decision is final
- Producers reserve the right to refuse entry
- All Around prize will be based on horse/rider combo
- Division splits will be 1/2, 1/2, 1 for the open barrels, 3/4 seconds for the youth barrels and 1 second for both the youth and open poles
